

# *Serving at Lake City in Hospitality*

**Greeters:** These volunteers strive to make each guest feel like our honored guest. With a friendly smile and a warm hello guests feel welcome the moment they walk through the doors.

**Host Team:** Host Team members know where everything is on the campus and are prepared to walk people to their requested destination. You also understand LCCC's core values and statement of faith.

**Guest Services Desk:** This team of volunteers assists our guests in navigating the waters of LCCC by providing them direction and additional information on the services and programs we offer.

**Ushers:** Ushers make people feel like an honored member of the family by taking care of all the physical logistics of our weekend worship services. They serve by seating individuals, receiving offerings, serving communion, assisting parents with infants, and handling general needs.

**Parking Lot Attendants:** Parking Lot Attendants are the first impression people have of LCCC. They direct drivers to help them safely navigate their way through our campus during the weekend and for special events.

**Golf Cart Drivers:** Occasionally attendees need help getting from their car to our front door. This team would be available in the parking lot prior to each service assisting those in need of a ride, handing out umbrellas, and being a friendly greeter. Adults only.

**HeBrews Café:** If you have a passion to make excellent specialty coffee drinks, then this ministry is for you! Team members are occasionally called upon for special events as well.

**Food Services Team:** This team prepares and serves meals and/or refreshments for a variety of special events.

**Java Dock:** Complimentary coffee and tea are always available during each service. This ministry makes LCCC feel like home to many of our guests and is considered a priority. It's the "little" things that mean a lot!

**Sundaes on Fridays:** Friday night has become a great family night here at LCCC. This team provides a yummy treat after each Friday evening service - ice cream!

**Building/Grounds Maintenance:** Some of us love to clean and others love to work outdoors to add to the beauty of well maintained grounds. If this describes you, join the Building & Grounds Maintenance Team. This may involve regular maintenance, seasonal snow removal or occasional projects.

**Encouragement Cards:** This ministry sends cards out to those with prayer requests, new births, hospital stays, and funerals. If you have the passion for writing, this ministry is for you!

**Friends at the Fireplace:** An opportunity to facilitate meaningful conversations with individuals who may want to take a next step in their journey with Christ, get involved in community here at LCCC, or are carrying a particular burden.

**Meals of Love:** The Meals of Love team prepares meals for people who are hurting. This team helps people through changes of life in a practical, compassionate way.

**Service Prayer:** Often times attendees to our services are moved by what has been spoken through the message or come with very pressing needs. The Service Prayer team is there immediately following each service to pray for or with those in need.

**Visitation:** This volunteer ministry visits and prays for people in the hospital.

# *Serving at Lake City in Worship Arts*

## *PERFORMING ARTS*

**Drama:** Rehearse, memorize and perform skits and other dramatic elements for weekend services and special events. Audition/interview required.

**Music:** Musicians and Vocalists—Must have sufficient ear training to hear parts and commit them to memory (sheet music not used). Audition/Interview/Experience required.

## *TECHNICAL ARTS*

**Stage Tech:** Work with sound, lighting, music, props and set design teams to implement set designs and setup/tear down stage for weekend services and special events. Includes carrying and placing sound equipment, instruments, wiring and set props.

**Video Tech:** Capture weekend service messages and special events using a digital video camera. Also capture video images for use to illustrate messages and promote events.

**Multi-Media Tech:** Run overhead slideshows and images in MediaShout presentation software and videos for weekend services and special events.

**Lighting Tech:** Control console operating stage and house lights for weekend services and special events.

**Sound Tech:** Assist and learn to operate digital console and outboard signal processors for stage and house sound mix for weekend services and special events. Experience required.

**Message Reproduction:** Digitally record weekend services, duplicate to DVDs and CDs and post MP3 files to website.

# *Serving at Lake City in Worship Arts (continued)*

## VISUAL ARTS

**Set Design:** Artists, Designers, Painters, Craftsmen and Helpers— Assist in designing, building, painting and erecting props and stage sets for weekend services and special events.

**Props:** Locate, borrow/purchase, create and set up stage props as message illustrations for the weekend services and special events.

**Video Production:** Capture, gather and catalog video images, create short vignettes and use non-linear editing programs to edit video for message illustrations and promote events for weekend services and special events. Experience required.

**Photography:** Capture, gather, edit and catalog still images of weekend services, special events, and specific subject matter for use as message illustrations, for special events and in church productions and publications, using digital still photography. Digital camera and experience required.

**Multi-Media Production:** Create slide presentations (using Power-Point and Media Shout) to enhance weekend service messages and special events by selecting graphic images and integrating text. Also create slide presentations of music lyric and ministry announcements. Experience required.

**Lighting Production:** Assist in designing lighting program and setting light positions, colors and focus in conjunction with set design.

## *Children's Ministry*

**Nursery:** Volunteers team together to provide a fun and safe environment for children ages Newborn-36 months, while parents attend services.

**Preschool:** Curriculum and classrooms prepared... we just need you! The Preschool Team helps teach Godly principals in an interactive and fun way. Ages 3-5 years.

**Kids Quest:** From Sound Tech to Small Group leaders, there's a place for you on our team. Here we build lasting relationships and partner with parents to guide children on their spiritual journey in an interactive, worship experience. Ages: K-3rd.

**Merge:** Merge is where our 4th-6th grade students come to grow in their relationship with God. Through Worship, Teaching and Life groups we help kids take their next step in their faith. You can help by joining the team as a Life Group Leader, weekly prep, stage/set design or run the tech and lighting. Ages: 4th-6th grades

**Check-In:** We are looking for a few volunteers to help guide parents through out check-in system. This is a great ministry opportunity that allows you to serve, but still attend services.

**Events:** Volunteers are always needed for special events, including Kid's Camp, Day Camps, Eggsperience, the Harvest Party, and Christmas events.

## *Revolution*

Revolution is the youth ministry for students in 7th-12th grades and consists of a weekly Wednesday gathering with life groups, and regular events. We're always in search of healthy adult leaders who are interested in investing in students.

Working with middle and high school students takes time and energy, but the payoff is certainly worth it. Leaders within the youth ministry serve in three different capacities:

Level 1 Leaders: Serve 1-2 times monthly

Level 2 Leaders: Serve 2-3 times monthly

Level 3 Leaders: Serve 3-5 times monthly (and up!)

There are many roles available, including graphic design, multimedia, series planning, event planning and administrative assistance. We want to utilize your strengths! Many volunteers in our ministry serve as life group leaders (Level 3), which has weekly time commitments building relationships with students and facilitating discussion groups.
